

Small Wreath Ornament



Note: You can always use smaller or larger hook to make it bigger or smaller

Materials:

- Worsted Weight Yarn (4 weight) Yarn – I used scraps I had
- Lightweight Yarn (2 or 3 weight) - I used Vanna’s Choice Glamour 2 weight
- 3.5mm E Hook
- Jingle Bell – I got mine at the dollar Store
- Ribbon of your choice (optional)
- Embellishment of our choice (optional)
- Tapestry Needle
- Twine for hanging (optional)

Abbreviations:

ST= Stitch
SC= Single Crochet
Crab Stitch or Backwards Sc

Pattern: With Red

Ch 41

Make 3 Sc in the 2nd chain from hook and in every chain across. Tie off; leave a tail to sew ends together at the end

Pattern: With Green

Ch 41

Make 3 Sc in the 2nd chain from hook ad in every chain across,

Attach 3 weight yarn and do a Crab stitch or a backwards Sc, tie off and leave tail to sew ends together

Now take both pieces and weave them together. Take ends and sew them together. Ta da! You made a tiny wreath
Now you can add your bell, ribbon and twine for hanging.
