

## C2C Unicorn Pillow



Corner to corner crochet seems to be the easiest, quickest way to make a blanket, pillows & more. Once you get the hang of the repeated stitch, you will be whipping things up like crazy.

\*Made this for my youngest and I hope you or your little one likes it too \*

**Size:** Approx.: 19" x 19"

**If you have any problems/ questions with this pattern, Please let me know, I will be happy to help**

### **Materials:**

- Size H hook
- 18" x 18" Pillow Insert (I got mine at Walmart.com for \$5.47 for 2 if you pick-up the item at the store)
- Your choice of Worsted Weight yarn (I used a combo of Red Heart Super Saver & Red Heart with Love)

**Abbreviations:**

Ch = Chain

Sc = Single Crochet

Hdc = Half Double Crochet

DC = Double Crochet

\*This pattern comes with a graph – graph reading is very helpful. You will start with a corner and enlarge from there and then decrease.\*

**Pattern:**

Chain 6

**Row 1:** DC in the 4th ch from hook and in the next 2 ch; turn - (1 block)

**Row 2:** Ch 6, dc in 4th ch from hook and in the next 2 ch - sl st into the ch 3 space of previous row, ch 3 and 3 dc all in the ch 3 space of previous row; turn - (2 blocks made)

**Row 3:** Ch 6, dc in 4th ch from hook and in the next 2 ch. - sl st into ch 3 space of previous row, ch 3, and 3 dc all in the ch 3 space of previous row, 2 times to give you 3 blocks.

Continue this pattern - adding 1 block per row for **Row 4 to Row 25**. (I did 25 rows and then started decreasing on row 26.) Please note the color changes on the graph.

**\*Decrease\***

**Row 26.** (after turning) sl st across each dc, sl st into ch 3 space of previous row. Ch 3, 3 dc into the ch 3 from previous row. Sl st into ch3 of previous row. Turn

\*Remember to follow the graph changes\*

\*\*\*Repeat Row 26 to Row 49. Fasten off.

**Curly's:**

\*For the red & Orange\*

Chain 21. 3 Hdc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook and in each chain, tie off & leave a tail to attach to pillow

\*For Green, Purple & Teal\*

Chain 25. 3 Hdc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook and in each chain, tie off & leave a tail to attach to pillow

**Border:**

**\*\*Before I put both side together I did the following to each side separate\*\***

Sc all around in WHITE, making 2 sc in each square area and 3 sc in each corner, sl st and tie off

**\*\*Now put the wrong sides facing each other (pretty sides out)**

**Row 1:** Hdc in each stitch around Making each side a different color, Sl st, Ch 1 & turn

Make sure you leave one side open to insert pillow, then do row 1 & 2 to close it up

**Row 2:** Scallop edge – 5 Dc in 1<sup>st</sup> stitch, \*skip a stitch, Sc in next st, skip a stitch, make 5 Dc in next stitch \*, Repeat

Tie off & weave in ends

I hope this pattern is easy to follow, let me know if you have any questions
