Crocheted Mickey/ Minnie Lovey

Size: blanket approx. 23" x 23"

Materials:

- Size F, H, I hooks
- Tapestry Needle
- Red Heart Super Saver White
- Red Heart Super Saver Black
- Red Heart Super Saver Red (Mickey)
- Red Heart Super Saver Sweet N Pink (Minnie)
- Stuffing

Abbreviations:

Magic Circle

Ch = Chain

ST= Stitch

SI St = Slip Stitch

SC= Single Crochet

ID (Invisible Decrease) = Single Crochet 2 together in front loop only (See Video Link for Help)

HDC = Half Double Crochet

DC = Double Crochet

Scallop = 5DC, skip 2, SI St, Skip 2, 5DC, Skip 2, SI st Repeat

Granny Square Blanket: I made 16 Rounds of Granny Squares (<u>I Hook</u>)
For Mickey I did DC around the end (3 DC in each ch 3 space ad then a DC in each DC stitch)
For Minnie I did sc around (3 sc in each ch 3 space, then sc in each Dc stitch). I then did the Scallop Stitch

Mickey/ Minnie Head: F Hook

Make 8 Sc in a Magic Circle, SI st, ch 1 (8)

Round 2: Make 2 Sc in each st, sl st, ch 1 (16)

Round 3: *Make 2 sc in 1st st, Sc in the next st*, repeat, sl st, ch 1 (24)

Round 4: *Make 2 Sc in 1st st, Sc in the next 2 sts, * repeat, sl st, ch 1 (32)

Round 5: *Make 2 Sc in 1st st, Sc in the next 3 sts, * repeat, sl st, ch 1 (40)

Round 6: *Make 2 Sc in 1st st, Sc in the next 4 sts,* repeat, sl st, ch 1 (48)

Round 6-16: Sc in each stitch, sl st, ch 1 (48)

Round 17: *ID the 1st 2 sts, Sc in the next 4 sts, * repeat, sl st, ch 1 (40)

Round 18: *ID the 1st 2 sts, Sc in the next 3 sts, * repeat, sl st, ch 1 (32)

Round 19: *ID the 1st 2 sts, Sc in the next 2 sts, * repeat, sl st, ch 1 (24)

Round 20: *ID the 1st 2 sts, Sc in the next 1 sts,* repeat, sl st, ch 1 (16)

Round 21: ID all around, sl st, ch 1 (8)

Round 22: ID around until closed

Tie off and leave a long tail to attach to Lovey

Mickey/ Minnie Ears: (I made 4 & put 2 together for a stronger ear (F Hook)

Make 6 Sc in Magic Circle, sl st, ch 1 (6)

Round 2: Make 2 Sc in each st, sl st, ch 1, (12)

Round 3: *Make 2 Sc in 1st st, Sc in next st*, Repeat, sl st, ch 1 (18)

Round 4: *Make 2 Sc in 1st st, Sc in next 2 sts*, Repeat, sl st, ch 1 (24)

Round 5: *Make 2 Sc in 1st st, Sc in next 3 sts*, Repeat, sl st, ch 1 (30)

I make 2 pieces, put them wrong side facing each other and slip stitch them together

Tie off and leave a tail to attach to head

Minnie Bow: H hook

Chain 15

Row 1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and across, ch 1, turn (14)

Rows 2-5" Hdc in each st across, ch 1, turn (14)

Tie off and weave in ends

Take your yarn and wrap around the center to make a bow.

Tie off and leave a tail to attach to head

All Done!
